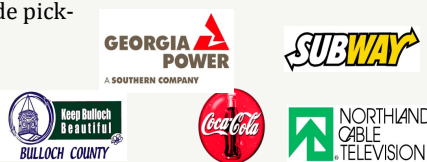

A warning will be sent to the offender notifying them that a member of their community witnessed the incident and also to inform them of the litter problem we have in Bulloch County.
