Keep Bulloch Beautiful will take part this year in a national program to reduce the impact of cigarette butt litter, the Keep America Beautiful® **Cigarette Litter Prevention Program**. In its fifth year with the program, Keep Bulloch Beautiful and the Downtown Statesboro Development Authority will target cigarette butt litter in the downtown Statesboro area through a concentrated and sustained effort.

The program’s strategic approach involves all stakeholders in the cigarette litter problem, including businesses, law enforcement, local governments, community organizations and, importantly, smokers themselves.

KBB Partners with Local Food Bank

Keep Bulloch Beautiful (KBB), the Statesboro-Bulloch County Food Bank, Georgia Southern University, and the Statesboro Farmer’s Market are pleased to inform you that a community garden will be available this summer and fall! Construction will begin this Saturday (July 16) at 9am at the Food Bank located at 900 East Jones Avenue (the old Sallie Z.).

The garden will be open to the public and anyone who is willing to work can reap the benefits. All we ask is that a portion of the food grown be given to the Food Bank.

The raised beds will be constructed by Boy Scout Troop # 340 from repurposed pallets provided by the Ellis Meat Market. Any plants are acceptable; they need not be edible. The soil and compost will be donated courtesy of Mr. Ellis Wood and Bulloch County. The seed for the items grown in the garden were donated courtesy of Tillman, Brannen, and Minick. Hoses and water will be provided by the City of Statesboro and KBB. This will truly be a Community Garden!
