Are you sick and tired of hauling you recyclables to the convenience centers each week?

Keep Bulloch Beautiful, Bulloch County and the City of Statesboro are pleased to announce that Single-Stream Curbside Recycling is being offered to the residents of the City of Statesboro for the annual fee of \$20.

Single-Stream recycling is a process in which materials can be co-mingled so there is no need to sort recyclables! Rinsed aluminum and tin cans and plastic bottles (**numbers 1 and 2 ONLY**) can be recycled in the same bin as magazines, junk mail, newspaper, paper, cardboard, and plastic bags.

Glass will still need to be brought to the county's Recycling Centers; it **CANNOT** be included in the curbside recycling cart at this time. If you are interested in participating in this wonderful program please contact the Bulloch County Public Works Office at (912) 764-0124 to reserve your cart!

- ▲ Laundry Detergent Jugs
 - ▲ Steel/Tin Cans
